One in 3,500 young boys is born with this disease. DMD knows no boundaries and crosses all cultures. Boys are typically diagnosed before the age of five and have trouble walking before age ten. Due to progressive muscle deterioration, they will be in wheelchairs between the ages of 10-12 years old. The simplest of tasks, such as holding a fork or turning over in bed will become very difficult.

There currently is no cure.

CureDuchenne™ is a non-profit, charitable organization committed to finding a cure for DMD. CureDuchenne™ was founded by Minnesota native Paul Miller and his wife Debra. Paul and Debra's only child has been diagnosed with this disease.

CureDuchenne™ works arm-in-arm with doctors and scientists to identify viable research projects and clinical trials to fund. The goals – to find a cure and bring life-saving drugs to help **this** generation of boys.
